CAMP NURSE/CLINIC AIDE POSITION DESCRIPTION

Mission:

General Function:

Working in collaboration with Camp administrators, School Health Coordinator, and counselors, the Camp Nurse/Clinic Aide will follow and implement the established policies and procedures. The Camp Nurse/Clinic Aide is responsible for the management and administration of all camper medications. The Camp Nurse/Clinic Aide will also work with the camp database to monitor incoming campers and their health needs as well as communicate with camp families as needed on health concerns.

- Consult with campers, parents and faculty/staff regarding campers health needs and perform other health services and duties as assigned
- Maintain standard health room procedures for day-to-day health room management including medication administration, first aid, injuries, and illnesses
- Track camp illnesses and communicable diseases
- Perform other health and camp related duties as assigned
- Communicate, monitor, and enforce all COVID-19 mitigation policies and practices and respond to any positive cases during camp with appropriate action and communication
